### Continuing a path of progress

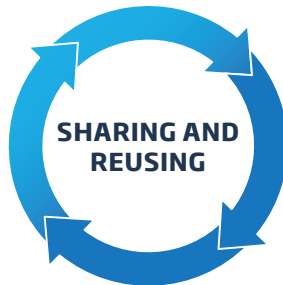
CHEP's business model successfully combines the circular and sharing economies and in FY17, our parent, Brambles circulated 590 million reusable platforms through a network of 500,000 customer touch points in over 60 supply chains worldwide. Each time our customers choose share and reuse solutions over one way packaging, carbon emissions are reduced, waste is avoided, and raw materials are saved.

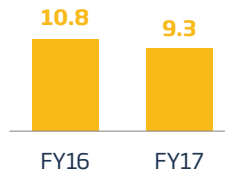

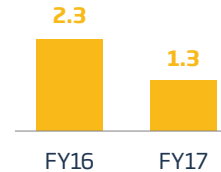

**LOST TIME INJURY FREQUENCY REPORT**



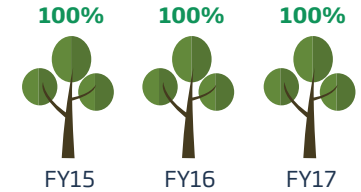

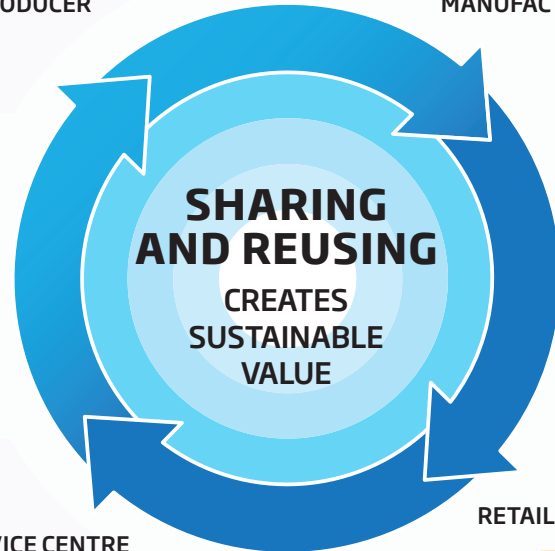
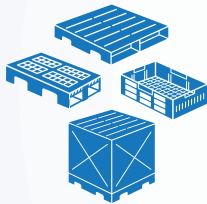
