STAGED CLOSURE OF BRISMEAT OPERATIONS

I am writing to confirm that Woolworths Group will cease all operations at our Brismeat facility by approximately 1 July 2018.

In October 2016 Woolworths announced our partnership with Hilton Foods Australia to build, own and operate a new Queensland Case Ready Meat Plant (CRM). At that time, we anticipated ceasing all Brismeat operations in 2020. However in an increasingly competitive sector, it is important for Woolworths to continue to find ways to improve our offer to our customers, and service our stores more effectively. Accordingly, since our announcement last year, we have continued to review the staging of the transition of our meat services to Hilton's CRM Plant.

As a result of our review, we have decided that work should cease at Brismeat earlier than previously anticipated in order to better facilitate the transition to Hilton's CRM.

The Brismeat Operations CHEP (**1610440661**) & Loscam (**420004**) accounts will cease trading after the 28th July, 2018 and any outstanding transfers after this time **will not** be reviewed. If early management of your account is not completed satisfactorily, this may lead to potential ULD losses against your account/s.

Additionally, if there is other outstanding equipment which should be returned, we ask that this is completed prior to 28th July, 2018.
