CHEP & Loscam ULD accounts closure**

The Woolworths Group has announced the upcoming closure of their Regional Distribution Centre at Hume, Victoria (MRDC) on the 31st January, 2020.

Whilst Melbourne RDC wind down their operation, this would be an opportunity for all our Trading Partners to review their CHEP & Loscam Pallet accounts and ensure all transfer of equipment (pallets and other ULD types) have been administered with your Supplier.

The Melbourne RDC CHEP (4000228861) & Loscam (314037) accounts will cease trading on Friday 31st January, 2020 and any outstanding transfers after this time **will not** be reviewed. If early management of your account is not completed satisfactorily, this may lead to pallet losses against your account/s.

Additionally, if there are other outstanding equipment which is required to be returned, we ask that this is completed prior to the 31st January, 2020.
